Baseball Leagues: (Age determined as of April 30.)

Ages 4-5 T-Ball Clinic: (Boys & Girls) Tee Ball & Coaches Pitch.

Ages 6-7 Intermediate Clinic: (Boys & Girls) A mix of Coaches & Players Pitch.

Age 8: 8-Year-Olds Only: (Boys & Girls) Players pitch entire game.

Ages 9-10 Little League: (Boys, but Girls can play also.) Modified Baseball Rules, 6 innings.

Ages 11-12 Major League: (Boys, but Girls can play also.) Regular Baseball Rules, 7 innings.

Ages 13-15 Pony League: (Boys, but Girls can play also.) Regular Baseball Rules, 7 innings.

Baseball Travel Teams Available for Age groups 9-10, 11-12 & 13-14.

(Tryouts begin in Jan/Feb; Mark on registration form under 'Comments' area, if interested in playing for one of these Travel teams; a separate fee will be charged for this, if your child makes the team.)

Softball Leagues: (Age determined as of December 31.)

Under 10: Softball: (Girls Only) Players Pitch Underhand, 7 innings.

Under 13: Softball: (Girls Only) Fast Pitch Underhand and Stealing, 7 innings.
